As one of the few super-yacht marinas found along the Mediterranean coastline, Marinturk Göcek Exclusive commenced operations this summer to provide superb service for 96 yachts.

Located just 20 minutes from Dalaman Int'l Airport, the marina is also only five minutes from yet another new marina, that of Marinturk Göcek Village Port in the adjacent Büngüş Cove. While Poruklu's natural formation offers protection against adverse weather conditions, it is

also the only cove in the region with a sandy beach. The floating piers at Marinturk Göcek Exclusive were specially designed to open or shut according to the prevailing weather. A portion of these piers has been set aside specially for each vessel. If they wish, yacht owners can utilize this section as a gazebo to get out of the sun and wind. Moreover, the Café Bistro, which juts out over the water, is a venue where yacht owners can spend pleasurable moments gazing into the fabulous panoramic view over a delicious meal.



Offering slipway, maintenance and repair services, Marintürk Göcek Village Port shall be at the beck & call of mariners throughout the year with its experienced crew.

The slipway zone at Marintürk Göcek Village Port has the capacity to berth 117 vessels in the water and 200 vessels on land, as well as travel lifters capable of hoisting 200 and 75 tons each, Marintürk Göcek

Exclusive offers berthing and land park services to both the marine as well as charter firms which sail through the region particularly during the summer months.
